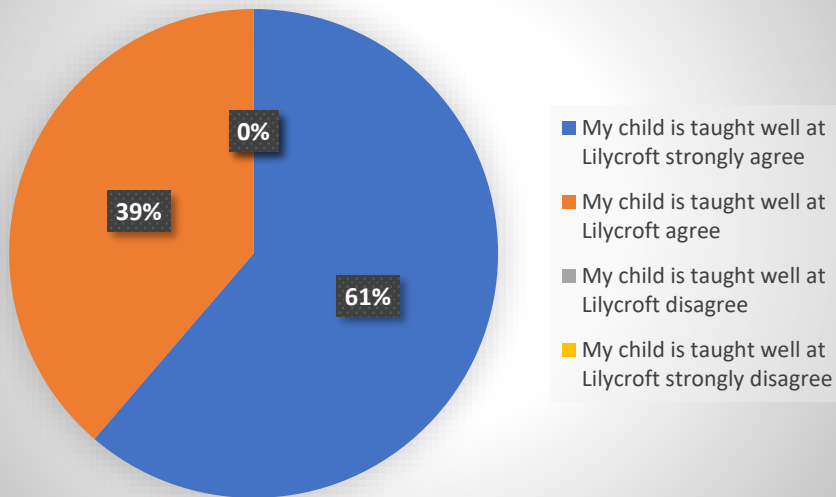
100% of parents agreed or strongly agreed that their child is happy at Lilycroft Primary School.

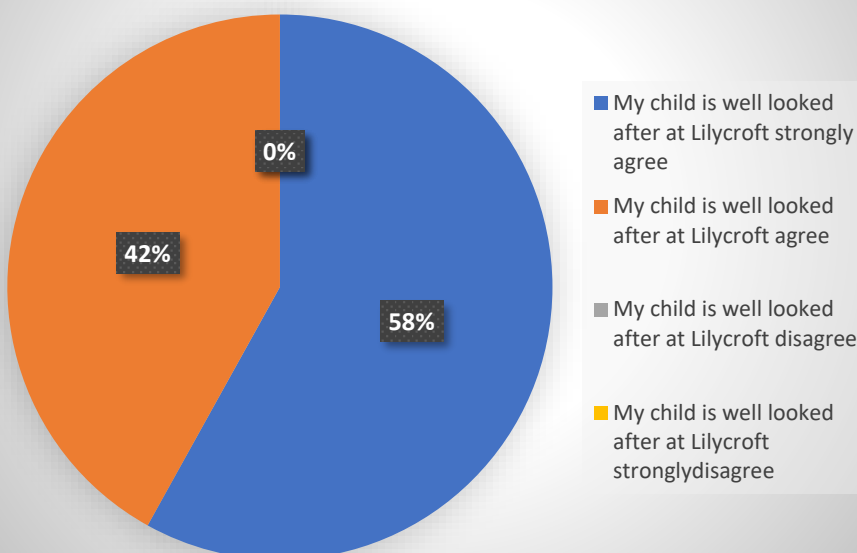
I am happy with the teaching methods that are used in school. Mrs Alam is very supportive and helpful. She is the star of the school. The new headteacher seems very good too.

Very happy with the teachers at Lilycroft Primary School. They are very helpful and listen to you if you have any concerns.

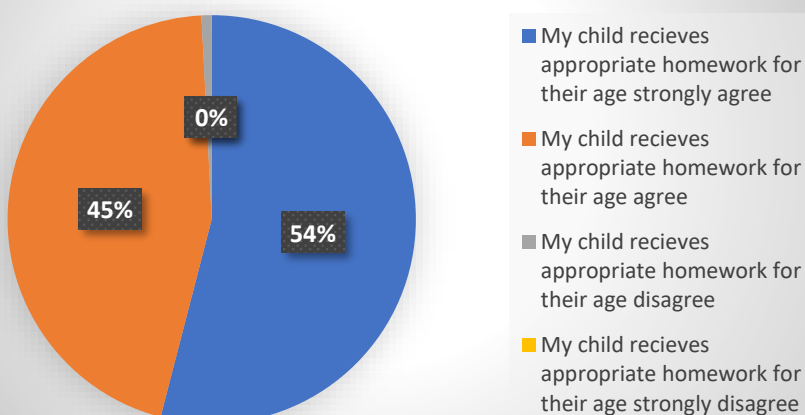
I love this school for my child. It has a real community feel and the leadership team are open and honest about the children's progress.

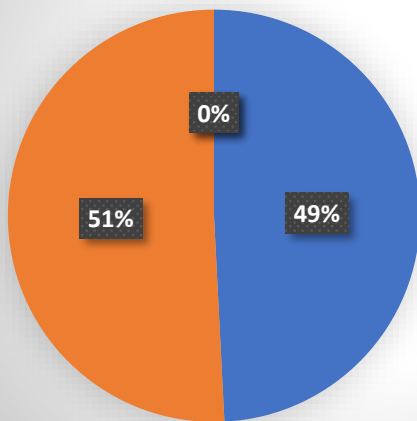

All my children at Lilycroft love the school. Thank you to all the staff and management.

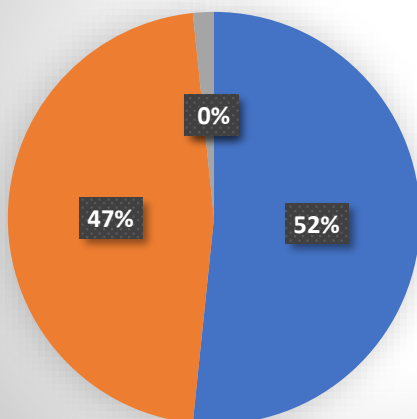
My child and I love the school. All the staff are very hard working. Mrs Alam is always helpful, kind and supportive.

I can't believe the improvement in my child and he has only been attending the school a few weeks! I am saying a big thank you to all the teachers and staff.

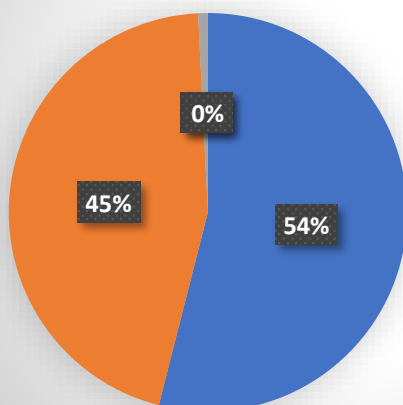

Lilycroft deals effectively with bullying



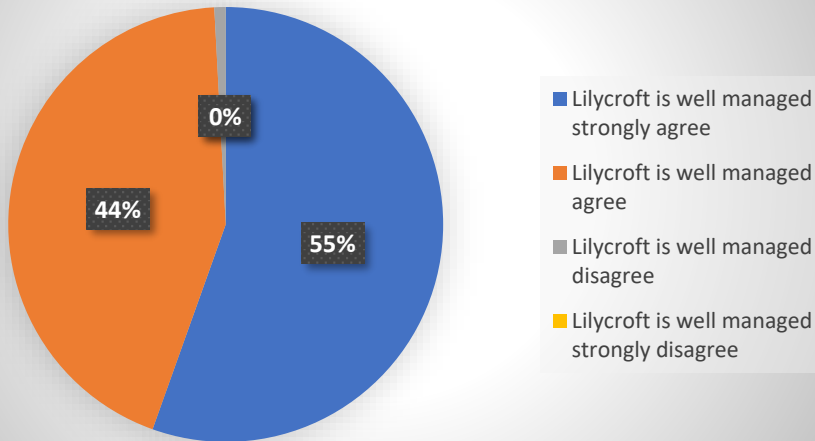
- Lilycroft deals effectively with bullying strongly agree

Lilycroft responds to any concerns that I raise

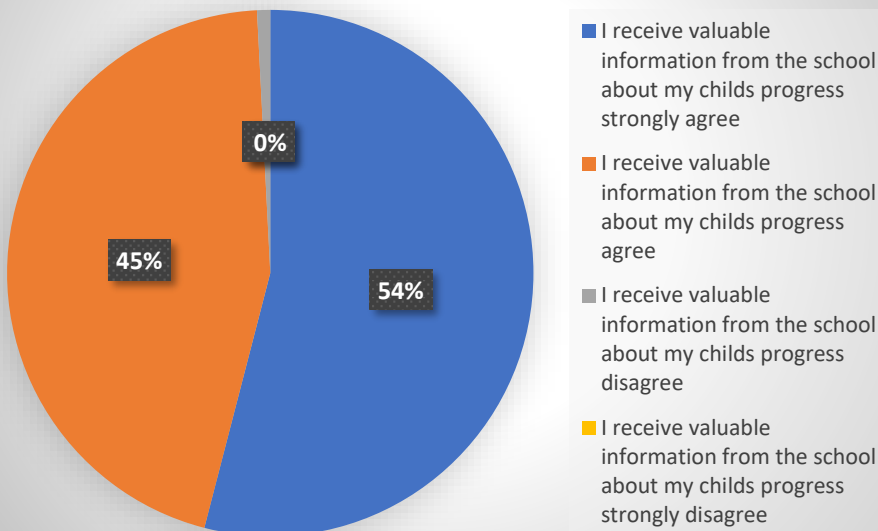


- Lilycroft responds to any concerns I raise strongly agree

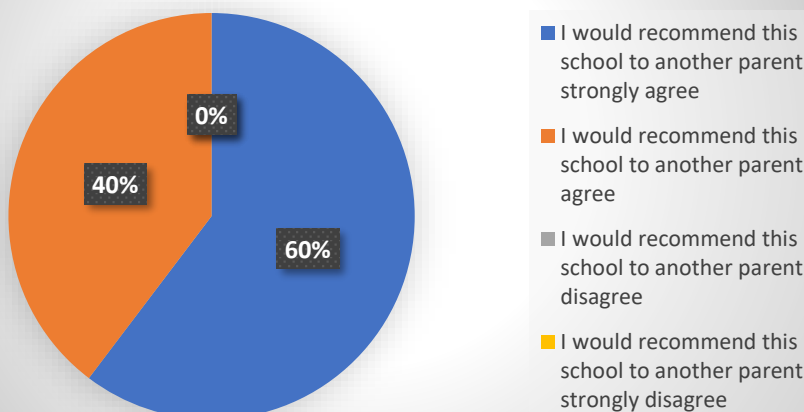

Areas identified by parents for development:

1. Review the layout and content of the school website.

Leaders are working on the content of the school website so that it has recent and accurate information available to view. The curriculum is being reviewed and full plans will be available by Summer 2023.

2. Provide a better after school club offer

Leaders have introduced an after-school club offer with 10 different activities being offered to enrich and broaden the opportunities available to our children.

3. For parents who find it difficult to attend in school meetings - inform parents about the school curriculum in a different way

Each teacher will provide a curriculum update each half term to parents. This will be sent out via Weduc. We hope this will keep parents better informed about what is being taught in school.

4. Keep parents better informed about school life and school updates

A weekly newsletter is produced which informs parents about school news and issues. We will also issue each term a calendar of events so parents are aware of the dates of relevant events.
