Reports will be given out on **Friday 14th July** and will inform you of the progress your child has made this year and also include any results from any statutory testing.






Eco Team Update

RSE Clarification

Relationship, Sex Education is a statutory subject that is taught throughout a child's schooling life. What those lessons look like in Primary Schools is very different to what it looks like at Secondary Schools. The subject is given that title as learning builds in that subject over time—much like History is always called History, the name stays the same.

In the primary phase the focus is on relationships. For example: Reception children are taught about family relationships—who is special to them and who is in their family. We also do a lot of work on friendships.

Children are taught about puberty and changes that will occur in their body in Year 5 and 6. We have recently consulted about teaching girls in Yr4 about body changes.




